


Join us for the expedition of a lifetime. Alongside award winning cinematographer, nat geo contributor & marine biologist , JOÃO RODRIGUES; We will experience the world renowned Fjordlands of Norway. Boasting unparalleled wildlife viewing and dramatic scenery, as well as the famous Arora Borealis – This is sure to be an exciting trip in the land of the Vikings.

9 day trip. 8 nights of accommodation. 5 boat days. Endless memories.

We will be heading to SKJERVOY, NORWAY to experience the amazing bio-diversity That comes along with the natural phonomenon of the herring run. This special season brings hundreds of Orca and Humpback whales to take part in an exciting aggregation of extremely active sea life. We will have the chance to not only witness this from the surface, but also to get into the water with these amazing animals for what will be a show to remember. Along with ocean adventure; Norway is known for Northern Light sitings during this time.



ORCA SWIMS

The opportunities we are looking for are when orcas are feeding on herring. The herring form bait balls for protection, and the orcas corral and drive them up to the surface, trapping them there. Once the herring are trapped, the orcas, and humpbacks (they join in the feeds sometimes), will stay in one area, slamming into the bait balls to kill their prey. – Allowing you to witness this extraordinary feeding event. WE WILL SPEND OUR TIME AT SEA, SEARCHING FOR THESE OPPORTUNITIES.

When the orcas are not feeding, they are hunting, which makes swimming with them difficult and brief. On the days that we do not find a baitball, we will try and slip in with them for a quick look to see them as they swim by. Occasionally, the orcas take an interest in us and will come in for a close look. On days they do not feel social, we will follow them around, watching and photographing them from the surface until they hopefully round up a baitball to feed on.

THE NOTHERN LIGHTS

Northern Lights (Aurora borealis) are the result of collisions between gaseous particles in the Earth's atmosphere with charged particles released from the sun's atmosphere. Variations in color are due to the type of gas particles that are colliding. Here you can watch these breathtaking dances of light move and change into their many forms – from patches or scattered clouds of light, to streamers, arcs, or rippling curtains that light up the sky with an eerie glow. After dinner, in the late evening, if the skies are clear, we will head out into the darkness, to search for the Northern Lights.



OTHER WILDLIFE

In the event of bad sea conditions and being unable to follow the orcas and humpback whales in the open ocean; Our skipper will take us to a coastal sheltered area, along the fjords, where it is possible to see and photograph sea eagles, reindeer, moose, and more.

THE BOAT

The Merry Fisher Marlin: Crossover of the Seas. Merry Fisher Marlin models are characterized by an inverted windscreen and a walkaround deck plan. Safety, performance and fuel efficiency are assured in this line by an excellent level of security on board, a proven hull and an outboard engine. The line features a contemporary, adventurous spirit, inspired by Scandinavian style and adapted to meet the needs of our daily expeditions.

RECOMMENDED GEAR

We are fully available to help you select the right gear for you! Nixi is also able to offer discounts on gear bought through us... Or help you find great used gear.

Water temperatures during the month of November range from 8oC to 6oC (46–42oF). Every diver is required to have the following:

Dry suit or apnea wetsuit (7mm+), hood, gloves (5mm+), boots or socks (5mm+), fins, mask, snorkel and weight belt.

Please be very careful to make sure you have all the equipment mentioned on the list above. There will be no diving gear for rent in Skjervoy. For the ones using apnea neoprene suits, we strongly recommend using waterproof jackets above the suits on the way back to the marina.

Air temperatures during the month of November range from 3oC to -3oC (38-25oF). Dress is casual. We recommend you to wear WARM and COMFORTABLE cloths: long underwear (fleece, wool, merino), warm jumper/jacket, beani, gloves and warm, waterproof shoes/boots.



EXPEDITION LEADER JOÃO RODRIGUES

Cinematographer, Marine Biologist, Conservationist



João Rodrigues is a Filmmaker, Photojournalist and Marine Biologist specialized in Nature and Conservation.

During his professional career, which has taken him to dive from the icy waters of the Nordic seas to the coral reefs of the tropics, collaborated on documentaries such as "Europe's Wild Islands" by National Geographic Channel, "Blue Planet 2" by BBC, "Oasis – Azores Islands–North Atlantic Ocean" by NHK, "+ or – 5 mètres" by the Arte channel and "Life at the Extreme–Deep / Azores" from the iTV channel. Currently, João Rodrigues is a contributor to National Geographic and director of production company Chimera Visuals, through which he made the film "Cavalos de Guerra", distinguished in

environmental film festivals

in the United States, Argentina, Mexico, England, among others. He also works as Director of Photography on nature and wildlife films from international producers, such as Bonne Pioche and Passion Planet. Awarded in internationally renowned photography competitions such as the European Photographer of the Year, the Underwater Photographer of the Year and the SIENA International Photo Awards in 2021, João was the first Portuguese to win a first place in the prestigious competition of London Natural History Museum, Wildlife Photographer of the Year. João Rodrigues' mission is to tell stories of the oceans through those who believe be one of the most important tools for community awareness, the visual storytelling.
